Cross-Cultural Reflection

Spend some time journaling about these experiences, particularly in light of the Approaching Differences diagram. We will talk together in our next seesion about the Approaching Differences diagram/model for interacting and we'll debrief your reflections.

- Try to identify when you were "green-lining" and why. What was going on for you?
- Do you notice any patterns?
- What are you learning about moving from red-lining to green-lining?
- What questions do you have?
